

DECLARATION FOR WIDOWS PENSION

State of New York ()
County of Delaware (ss:)

On this 11th day of June 1901, personally appeared before me
A Notary Public in and for the Village of Deposit within and
for the County and State aforesaid Clarrisa N. Scriver aged
79 years, A resident of Town of Sanford County of Broome and
State of New York, who being duly sworn according to law, de-
clared that she is the widow of Jeremiah Scriver, who enlisted
under the name of Jerry Scriver, August 29th, 1862 private
in Co. E. 70 Regt. N. Y. Vol. Inf., transferred to Co. G 85
N. Y. Vol. Inf. Discharged July 7th, 1865 Number of Pension
Certificate, 382930, and served at least 90 days in the late
war of the rebellion, in the service of the United States; who
was honorably discharged July 7th, 1865 and died March 13th, 1901,
That the soldier was not in in the military or naval
service, of the United States, except as above stated.

That she was married under the name of Clarrisa N. Partridge
to said ~~late~~ Jeremiah Scriver September 23rd, 1863, there
being no legal barrier to said marriage said Jeremiah Scriver
had been previously married to Mrs Mary Clendening Betsey
Clendening and Wanda Soules, but they were all dead at the time
I married him. That she has not remarried since the death
of the said Jeremiah Scriver. That she is without other means
of support than her wifes labor, during their marriage there
was born to them nine children none of said children are under
the age of 16 years.

That she makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed
on the pension roll of the United States under the provision
of the act of June 27th, 1890.

She hereby appoints J. R. Wade of Deposit N. Y. her true and
lawful attorney to prosecute her claim and receive a fee of \$100
