"Henry (Henrij) Sheer Schryver was born on 14 November 1781. He was baptized on 20 January 1782 in Poughkeepsie NY. His sponsors were Johannes and Marytje Sheer. Details of his death are not known other than he probably died before 1844. Henry married Ruby Payne (or possibly Paine). We have no information on her. They were married, probably on 9 February 1779 in either Poughkeepsie or New Hackensack, New York. A date of 23 January 1779 has also been found, but this is probably the date of banns. They had eight (8) children. Records show different spellings of the surname and, in fact, the children's surnames also vary. They reside in Oswego NY.

Itis interesting to note that Henry named one son, Selah Paine Schryver. An early Methodist Circuit Rider named Selah Payne appears to have a connection to this family Selah's name appears on several property transactions with other Payne and Schriver's.
